Solveig Cox

Solveig Cox, a northern Virginia ceramist died In March at a senior care unit in Massachusetts. Solveig was a long-time JRA member, who served as a board member, participated in JRA Day and actively supported other JRA activities. She was also among the earliest and longest tenured artist at the Torpedo Factory in Alexandria. She was an indefatigable production potter whose work was sold her nationwide. Solveig was the daughter of Mariska Karasz, a textile artist, whose works are part of the Renwick Gallery permanent collection.
